






Your vehicle must be fitted with rear brakes. Why? If your front brakes were to fail for any reason, then a serious accident could occur. You will not be allowed to cruise if your vehicle is not fitted with rear brakes.




• Fuel storage is permitted at ASID during competition times only and must be removed after competition.

MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA

Any entrant that wishes to take part in the event must comply with the Motorsport Australia standards.

ANDRA

Any entrant that wishes to take part in the drag racing must comply with the <u>ANDRA standards</u>.
