Approved entrants who hold a blue, yellow or green permit are invited to park up. Entrants must be scrutineered first. If you have a Friday scrutineering time, reach out to the team and we will change it to Thursday so you don't miss out on the festivities. The Aces and Eights crew will be cruising to town and have invited any RCN entrant to join in.

Bojangles Saloon Bike Ride Through (new)

Ride your bike through this iconic Outback Pub in the middle of Alice Springs as part of the RCN Night Markets & Fringe Festival. Bikes must be a registered entrant of RCN11, and must have passed scrutineering. Rider and one passenger permitted to ride and helmets must be worn.



Show off your ride no matter whether it's a blown competition weapon, a lovingly restored stocker or anything in between! Park up and enjoy the views and festivities that Lasseters has to offer. Lasseters will be the new home for Shannons Show'n'Shine events, with dedicated lawns for display and show events, and indoor exhibition calls, amphitheatres and zone for elite, car clubs and Jetcor Bike Show.

With a bigger program of Show Cars in 2025, Lasseters will turn on from Friday night and the best part is you are free to leave and come back as often as you want!


NEW FOR RCN11 — MULTIPLE ENTRY PASS

WHO CAN DO IT

- Any entrant who has passed Scrutineering with their vehicle
- Passengers are welcome but they MUST be in a seat with a seatbelt on and have signed the passenger waiver form, which will be available on the day
- All vehicles must run a bonnet for the Power Skid Fest
- Passengers must be 18 over.

With a cash bar, live tunes, and a crowd full of legends rocking their best flannies, it's the perfect way to wrap up another massive Red CentreNATS.


WHO CAN DO IT

Heavy Hitters will be the grand finale of an epic drag racing tri-series. It all kicks off with Nitro Up North, then ramps up as some of the country's top drag racers battle it out at the Desert Nationals. Finally, it all comes down to Saturday at Red CentreNATS, where the best of the best will go head-to-head in Heavy Hitters — the ultimate showdown to wrap up the series in serious style!



Heavy Hitters at Red CentreNATS is all awesome, heads-up, pro tree racing — and there's a massive prize pool of

Classes are run in time-based brackets. Don't break out!

Heavy Hitters is open to all fast cars and bikes. Choose your time-based class, rock up to the start line, and send it for your chance at big money, a trophy, and bragging rights.

Of all the amazing street machines that make their way to Alice Springs for Red CentreNATS our judges have the almost impossible task of crowning one of them the Red CentreNATS Champion, and handing them the Nigel Warr Trophy.

We demand that our Champion be as tough as the outback terrain we hold the event on, so they've got to look the part and appease our judges as well as compete in 2 separate driving disciplines.

If you've built the ultimate hot rod and can dominate in the show judging and wow us with your skills behind the wheel, you'll go home with some serious prize money and the irrefutable title of Red CentreNATS Champion!

WHO CAN DO IT

Entrants must have passed scrutineering and have a fully road registered vehicle or appropriate Temporary Registration, suitable to the RCN Champion (Red Permit minimum). If you would like to compete for the Red CentreNATS Champion, the Chief Judge must be informed prior to the compulsory driver briefing at 2PM Saturday 6 September 2025.













TARMAC TIME TRIAL

Red CentreNATS is all about having fun behind the wheel of your car in the heart of the country, but the truth is that not every entrant is a supercharged burnout car or a blistering quick drag racer. For those that have put together a modestly-powered street car and know how to spin the wheel, the Lasseters Motorkhana is the place where outright horsepower plays second fiddle to suspension, steering and skill!

And while the event has been dominated by compacts and nimble four-cylinder entrants in the past, that's not to say that we don't love to watch the muscle car guys have a go!

COMPETITION FORMAT

You only have seconds to manoeuvre your way through one very tight, short course without incurring any penalties.









SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering is your first stop on RCN weekend. Cruise in, get your car stickered up, and head out to enjoy everything Red CentreNATS has to offer. Our friendly scrutineers work hard to get you on the road as quickly as possible so have everything you need ready to go before you get there.


WANT TO SPEED UP SCRUTINEERING?

- If you need a temporary permit fill in the application (available on the website), then send it to rcnadmin@summernats.com.au

 Please note, to obtain a temporary permit you will need to produce and show your physical driver's licence to the Motor Vehicle Registry Staff at Scrutineering. Digital copies are not accepted in the Northern Territory.

TRAILER OR TRANSPORTER PARKING

- Trailer parking is available at ASID
- Trailer parking is also available at Lasseters but will be limited to those in the Elite Hall and participating in the Show and Shine.
- If you and your mates are all coming to Alice Springs on a transporter, we need to know so we can make space for you and your crew! Send us an email: rcnadmin@summernats.com.au





If you need to fuel your car during the event, we've got you covered. Your beast won't go thirsty!

EVERYONE NEEDS FUEL

- Fuel storage is permitted at ASID during competition times only and must be removed after competition.
- Fuel cannot be stored overnight.
- You can bring your fuel in safe and approved portable containers.
- Fuel must be stored in a well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight.
- Multiple containers are not to be stored together, and all containers are to be capped when not in use.
